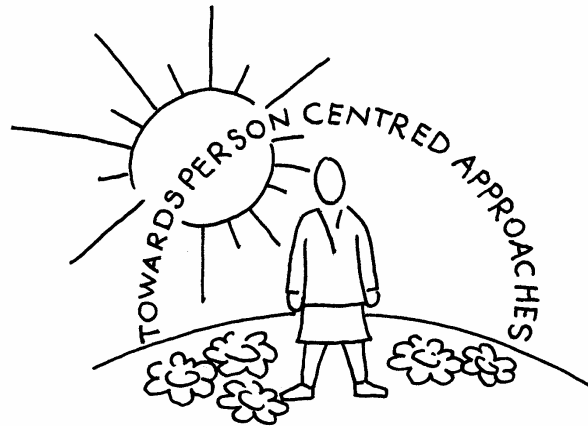

Year 1



4 people to attend 'Train the Trainers' day

Review services using Person Centred Approaches

Set up a network and keep a register of facilitators

Hold an information day for service users, their families and carers

Produce easy read information

All services to put together a plan to deliver 'breadth' and 'depth' training

Make all other subgroups of the Partnership Board aware of PCP

Send a report each year to the Partnership Board

Grey box = Task achieved

Green box = Task partly achieved

Blue box = Task not achieved

Years 2 and 3



More 'depth' and 'breadth' training made available for facilitators, service users and carers

Look at how useful the PCP has been for service user

All services using PCP and Person Centred Approaches

There will be facilitators to support PCP across East Sussex

Grey box = Task achieved

Green box = Task partly achieved

Blue box = Task not achieved

More people will receive PCPs if they want one

Report to Partnership Board

All young people leaving children's services to move into adults' services will receive a PCP

There will be easy access information about PCP for residents of East Sussex
