Steyning East Rural District Council

Steyning East consisted of the parishes of West Blatchington, Fulking, Hangleton, Patcham, Portslade, Poynings and Preston Rural. In 1898 Portslade became a separate Urban District. In 1928 Steyning East Rural District Council was abolished: West Blatchington (except for a small portion east of Dyke Road which went to Brighton), Hangleton, a small part of Patcham and Preston Rural were absorbed by Hove Borough Council, Patcham (except for a small portion west of Dyke Road which went to Hove) went to Brighton County Borough Council, and Fulking and Poynings went to Cuckfield Rural District Council.
