**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Horam 25 (part))
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2017**

To protect public safety during the construction of a crematorium, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 22 September 2017 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath:-

Temporary Footpath Closure

A section of Public Footpath Horam 25 will be closed to all users between TQ 5714 1610 and TQ 5746 1606 for 325 metres. An alternative route is available.

The closure will be in force for 12 months until 31 March 2019, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
