### **The East Sussex (Public Footpath Rye 39) (Public Footpath Closure) Temporary Notice 2018**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of public footpath Rye 39, between TQ 920 210 and TQ 920 211. The closure is necessary to protect public safety whilst excavations are undertaken to connect a new sewer close to the path.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 21 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

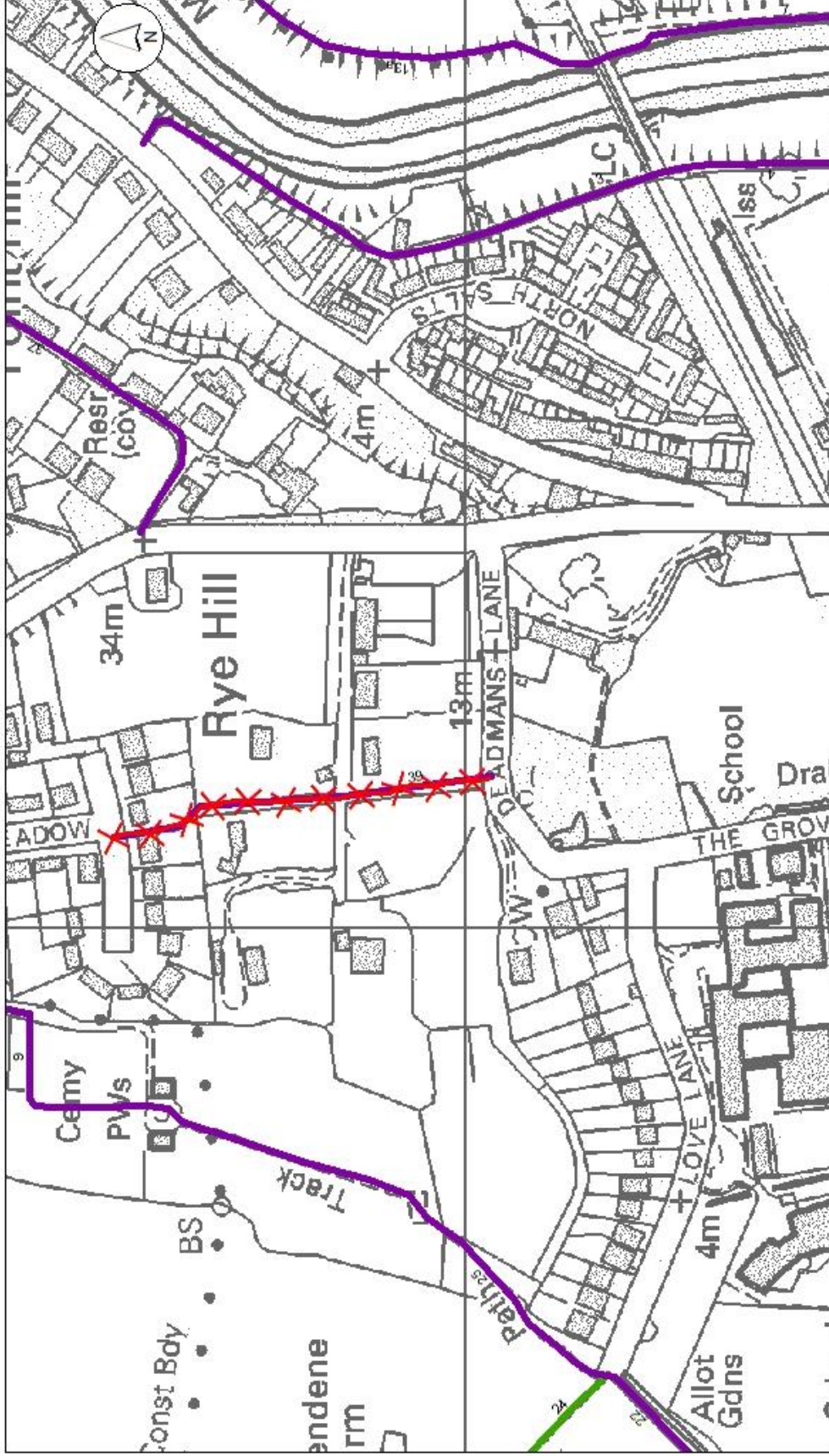
