The East Sussex (Public Bridleway Wivelsfield 18 and Public Footpaths Wivelsfield 16 and Wivelsfield 35/Plumpton 3) (Public Bridleway and Footpath Closure) Temporary Notice 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of Public Bridleway Wivelsfield 18, between TQ 357 201 and TQ 357 193 and Public Footpaths Wivelsfield 16 (TQ 356 199 TQ 357 199) and Public Footpath Wivelsfield 35/Plumpton 3 (TQ 357 199 to TQ 368 188). The closure is necessary to protect public safety during surface repairs to Wivelsfield Bridleway 18. The bridleway is likely to remain closed for up to 3 weeks; possibly longer to horse riders to give the new surface time to consolidate.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 21 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

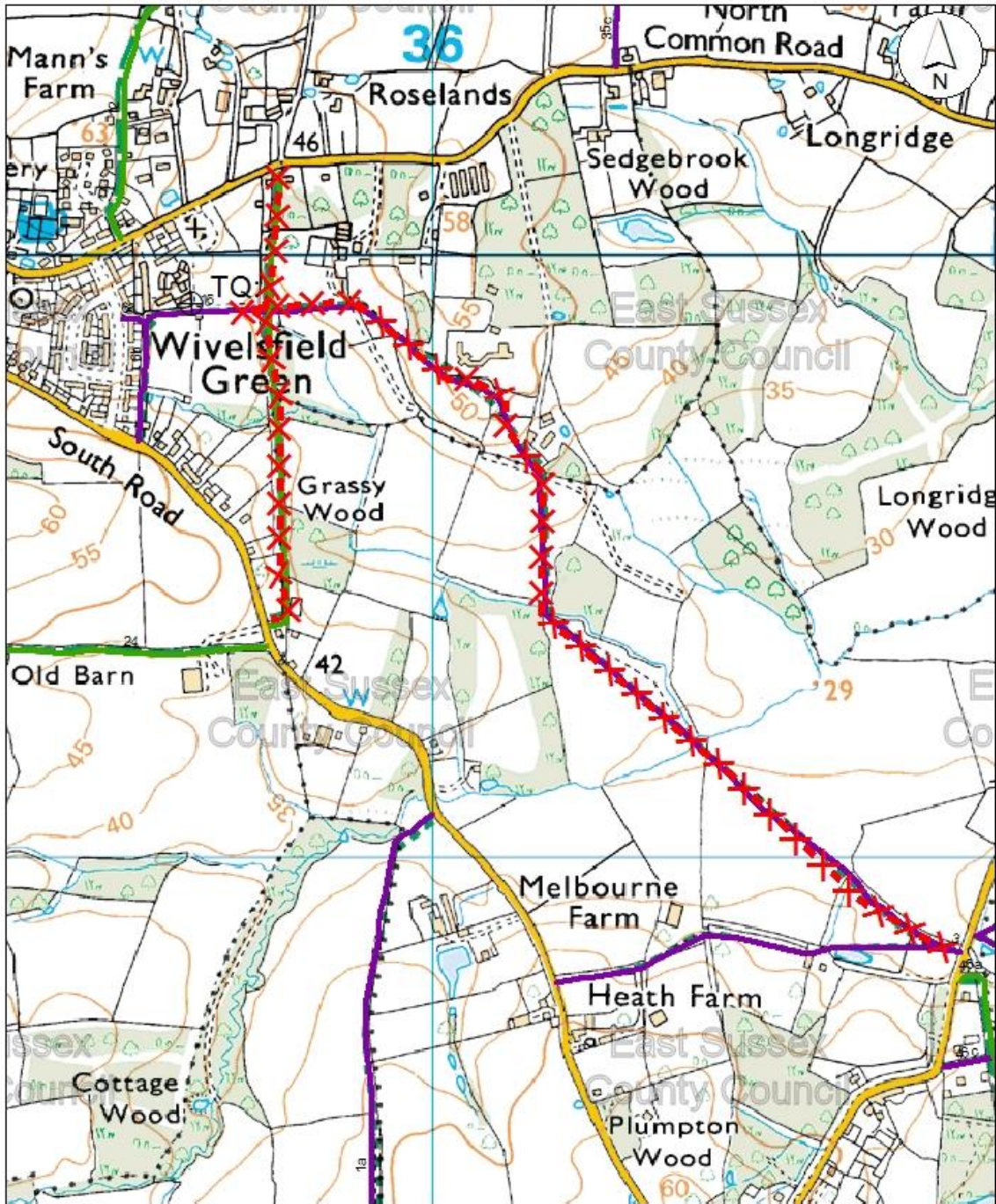
