**The East Sussex (Public Bridleway Streat 7g)
(Temporary Bridleway Closure) Order 2018**

To protect public safety and allow machinery access during the reconstruction of a railway bridge over bridleway Streat 7f, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following bridleway:

Temporary Bridleway Closure

The whole of **Public Bridleway Streat 7g** will be closed between TQ 3514 1584 and TQ 3546 1628. No alternative route will be available.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 28 August 2018, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the bridleway still be unavailable to use.

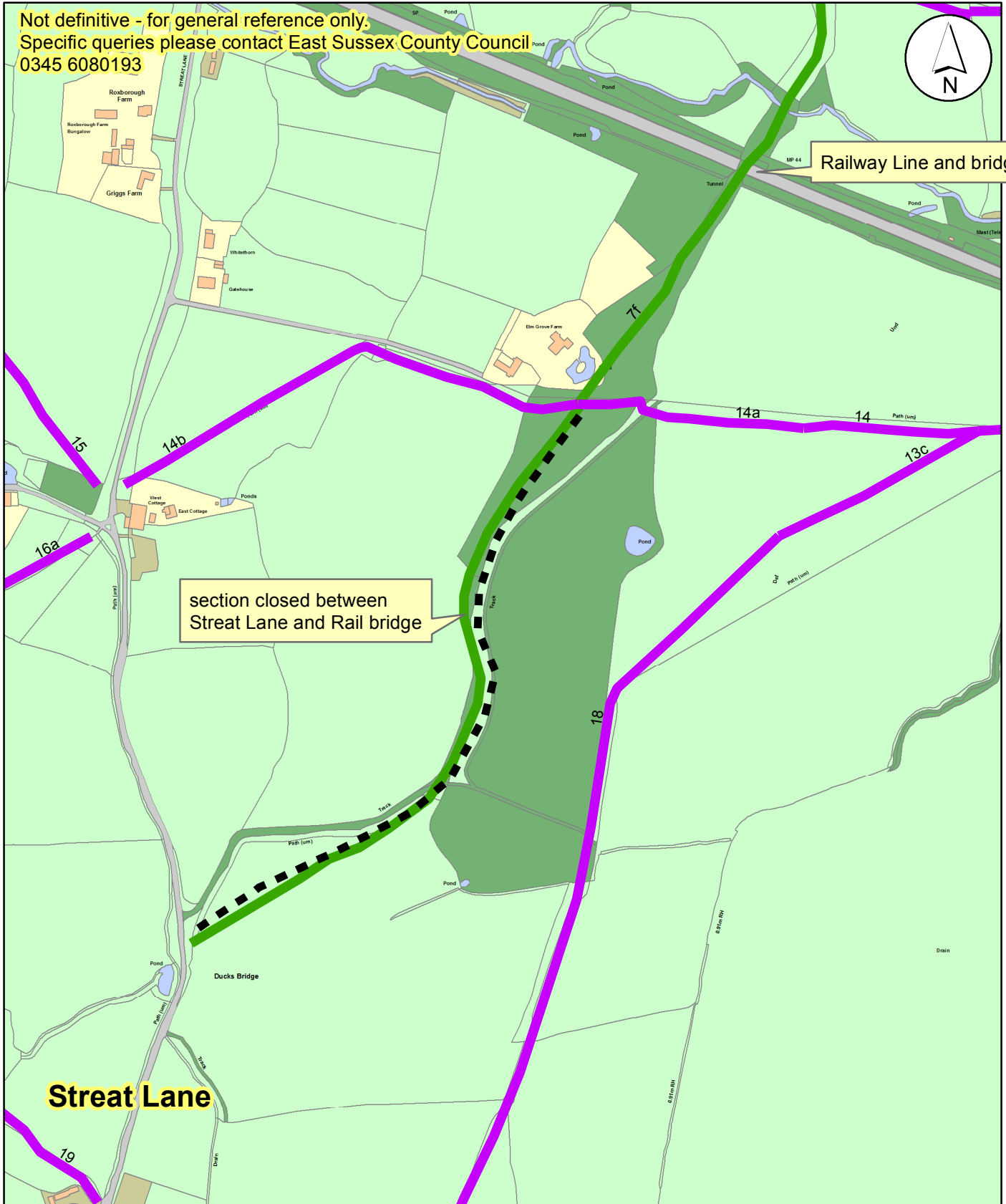
