The East Sussex (Public Footpath Mayfield and Five Ashes 54a) (Public Footpath Closure) Temporary Notice 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of public footpath Mayfield and Five Ashes 54a, between TQ 599 277 and TQ 603 274. The closure is necessary to protect public safety whilst South East Water replaces a water main. An alternative route will be available via Mayfield and Five Ashes 51c and 48 and vice versa.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 42 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

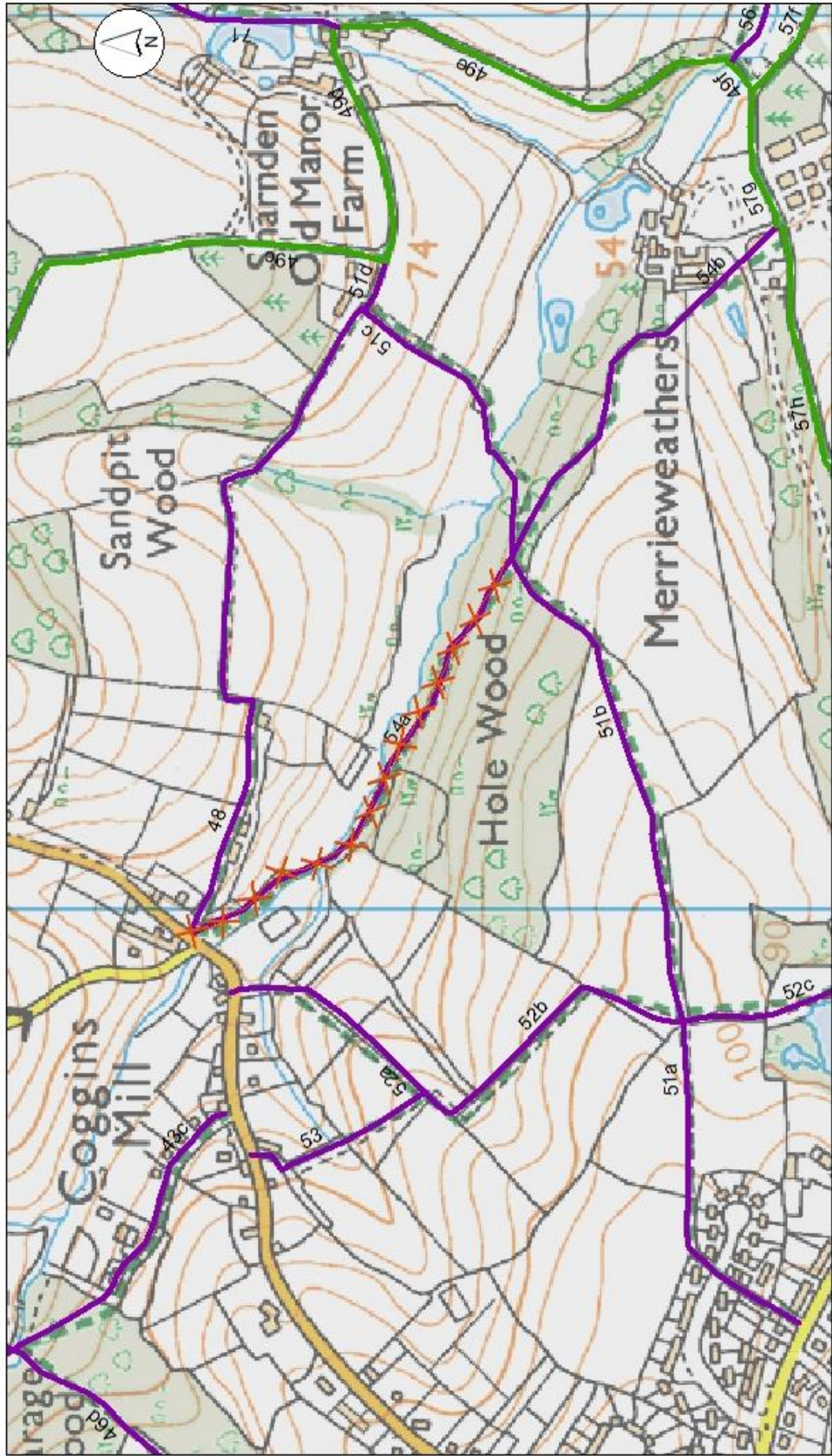
