The East Sussex (Public Byway Laughton 26e)

(Public Byway Closure) Temporary Notice 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of public byway Laughton 26e, between TQ 520 138 and TQ 519 139. The closure is necessary to protect public safety whilst forestry work is undertaken nearby. An alternative route for walkers will be available via Footpath 31a. There is no alternative for horse riders or other users. The byway will be open outside of operational hours to minimise disruption.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 42 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

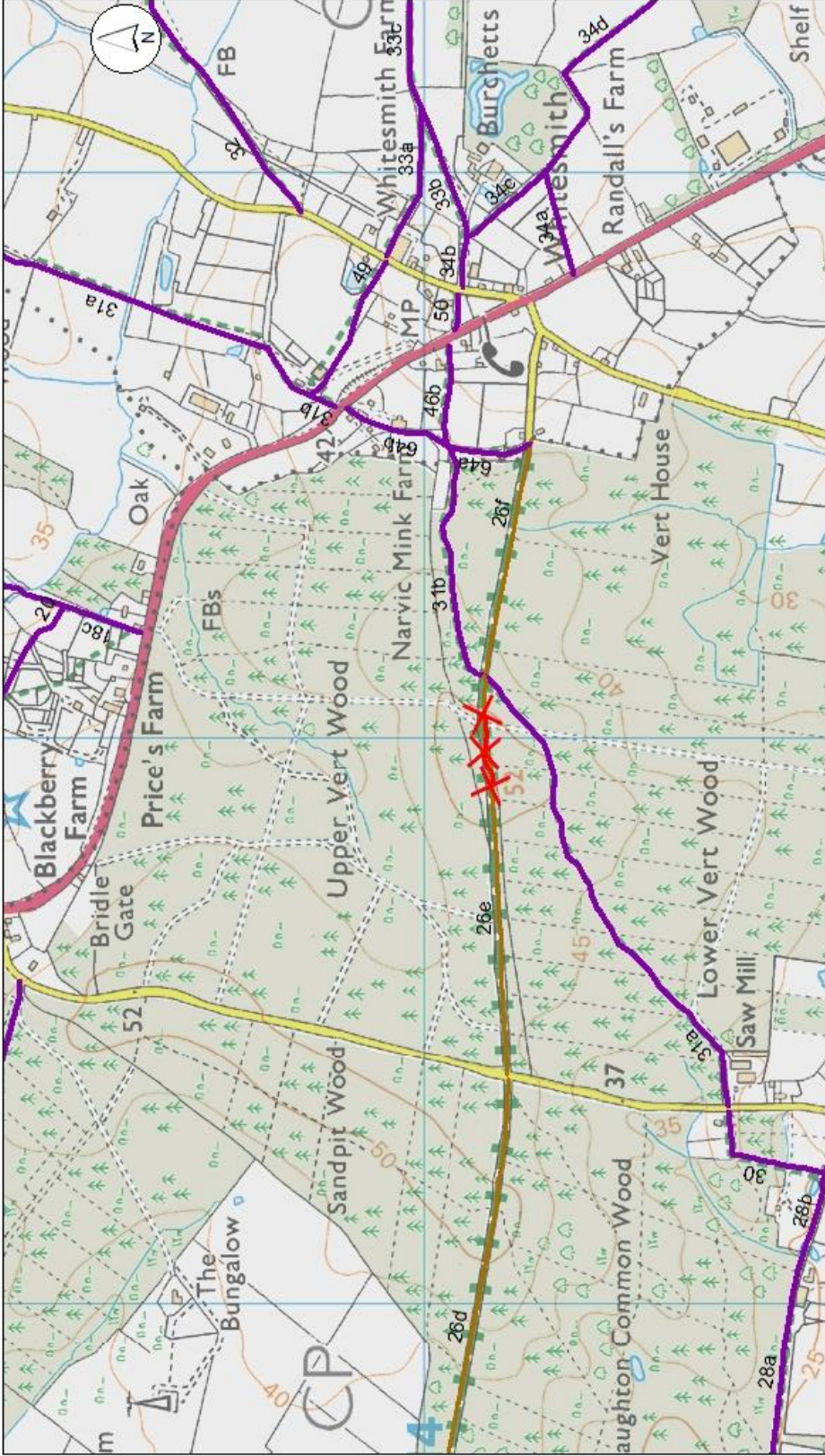
