The East Sussex (Public Footpath Barcombe 45a) (Public Footpath Closure) Temporary Notice 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of public footpath Barcombe 45a, between TQ 54128 11691 and TQ 54137 11664. The closure is needed to protect public safety whilst a bridge which is in a potentially dangerous condition, awaits repair.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 42 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

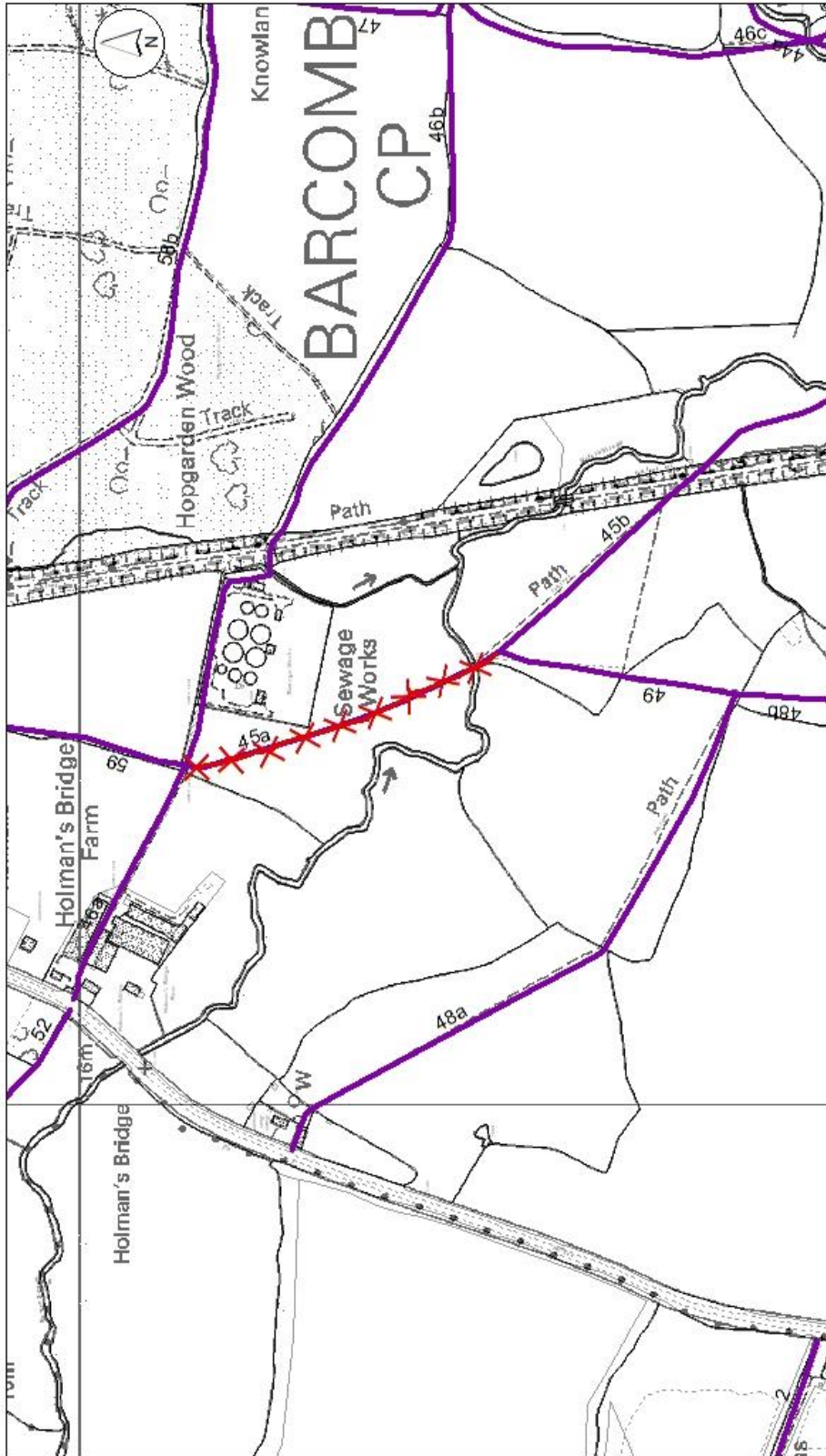
