The East Sussex (Public Bridleway Plumpton 42a, 42b, 42c, East Chiltington 32a, 28d)

(Public Bridleway Closure) Temporary Notice 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of public bridleway Plumpton 42a, 42b, 42c, East Chiltington 32a, 28d, between TQ 5356 1127 and TQ 5365 1169. The closure is necessary to protect public safety whilst the South Downs National Park Authority undertake surface improvement works. An alternative route will be signed as "South Downs Way temporary diversion" and will run parallel to the paths in adjacent fields.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 42 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

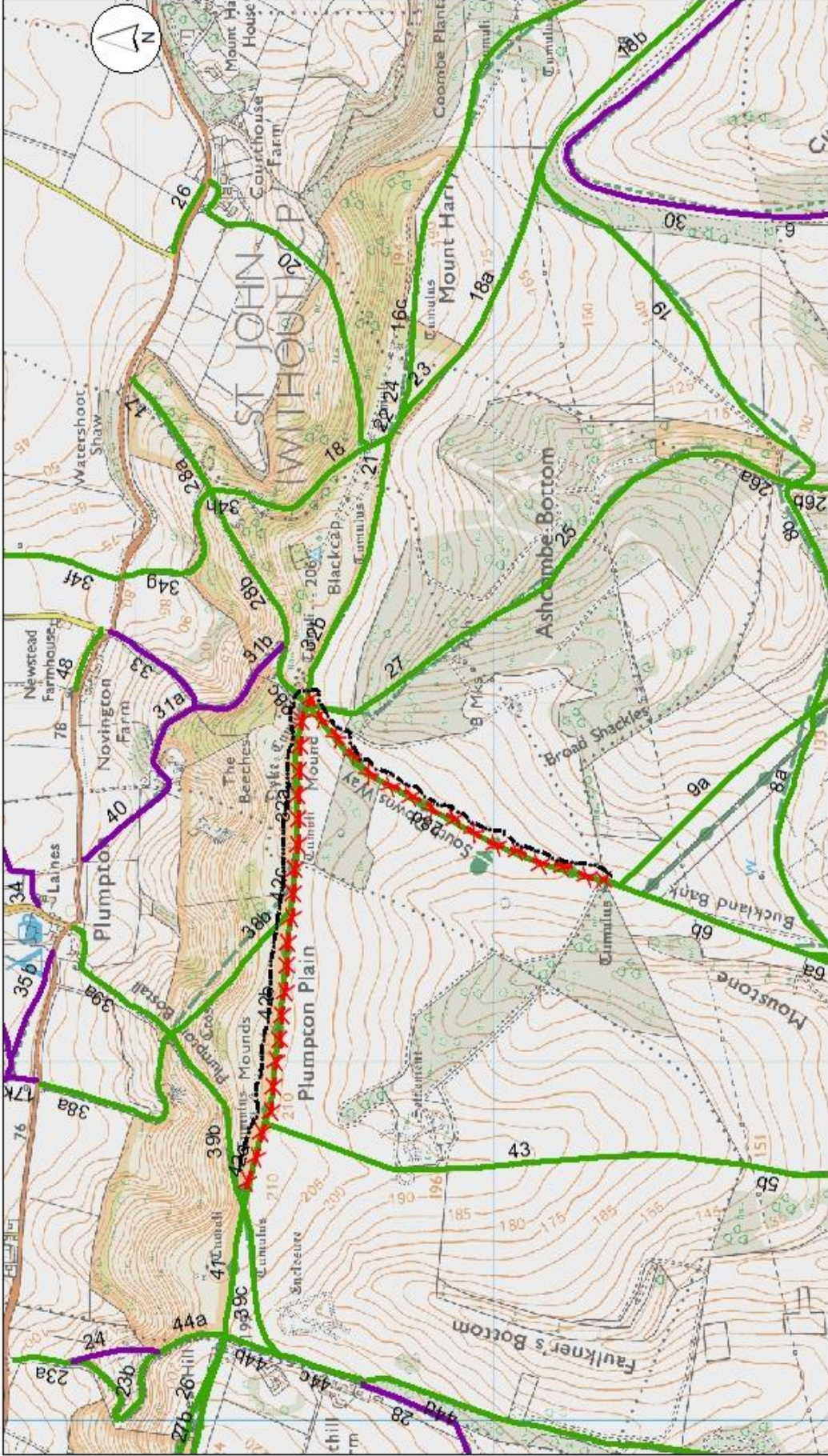
