**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Burwash 56d (part))
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2018**

To protect public safety while essential rebuilding work is carried out to Mill Pond, Park Mill on the Bateman's Estate, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath

Temporary Footpath Closure

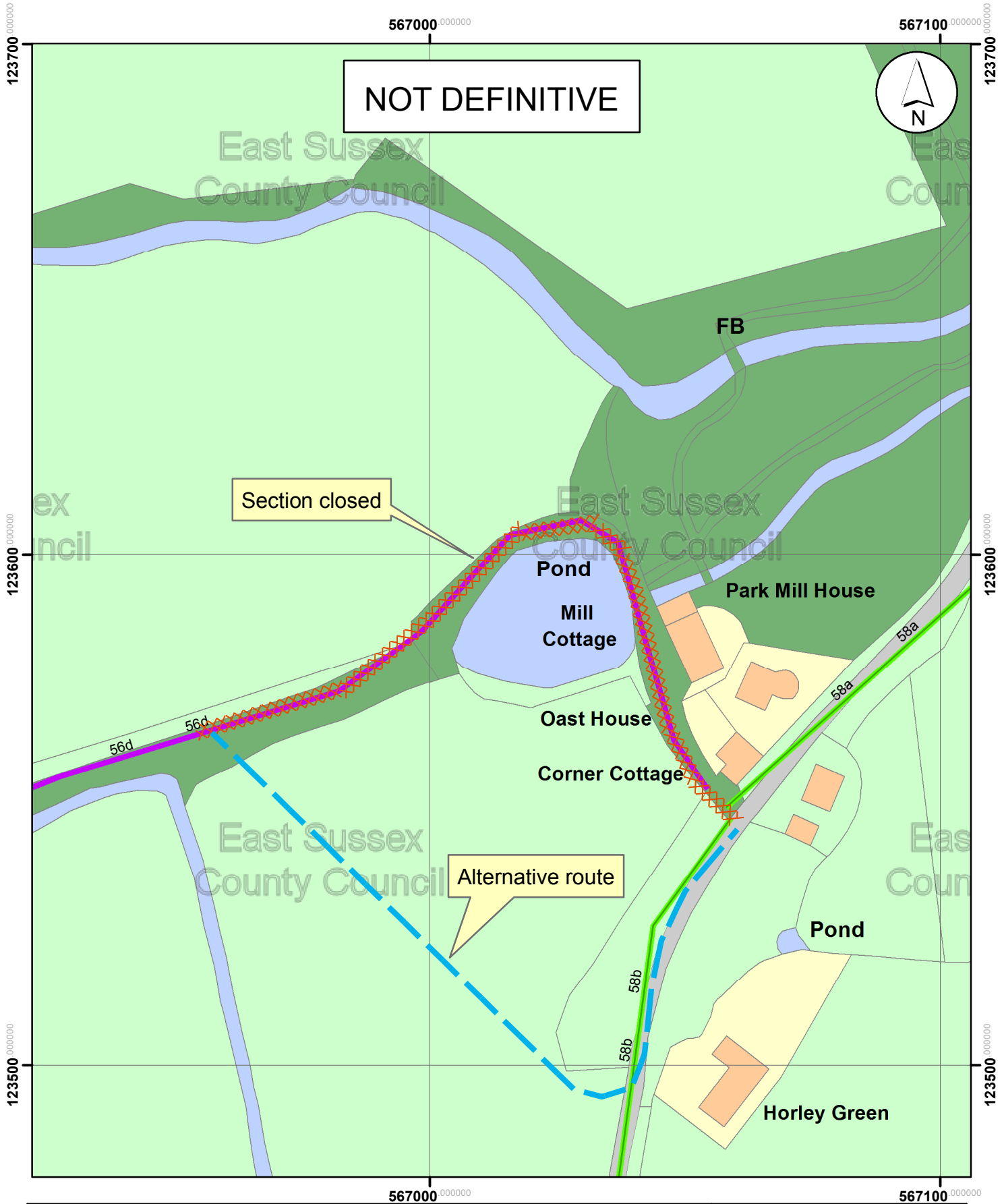
A section of **Public Footpath Burwash 56d** will be closed to all users between TQ 6705 2356 (where it joins Burwash bridleways 58a and 58b) and TQ 6695 2356 for a distance of 155 metres. An alternative route will be available.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 1 October 2018, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
