**The East Sussex (Public Bridleway Streat 7f)
(Temporary Bridleway Closure) Order 2018**

To protect public safety during the reconstruction of a railway bridge over bridleway Streat 7f, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following bridleway

Temporary Bridleway Closure

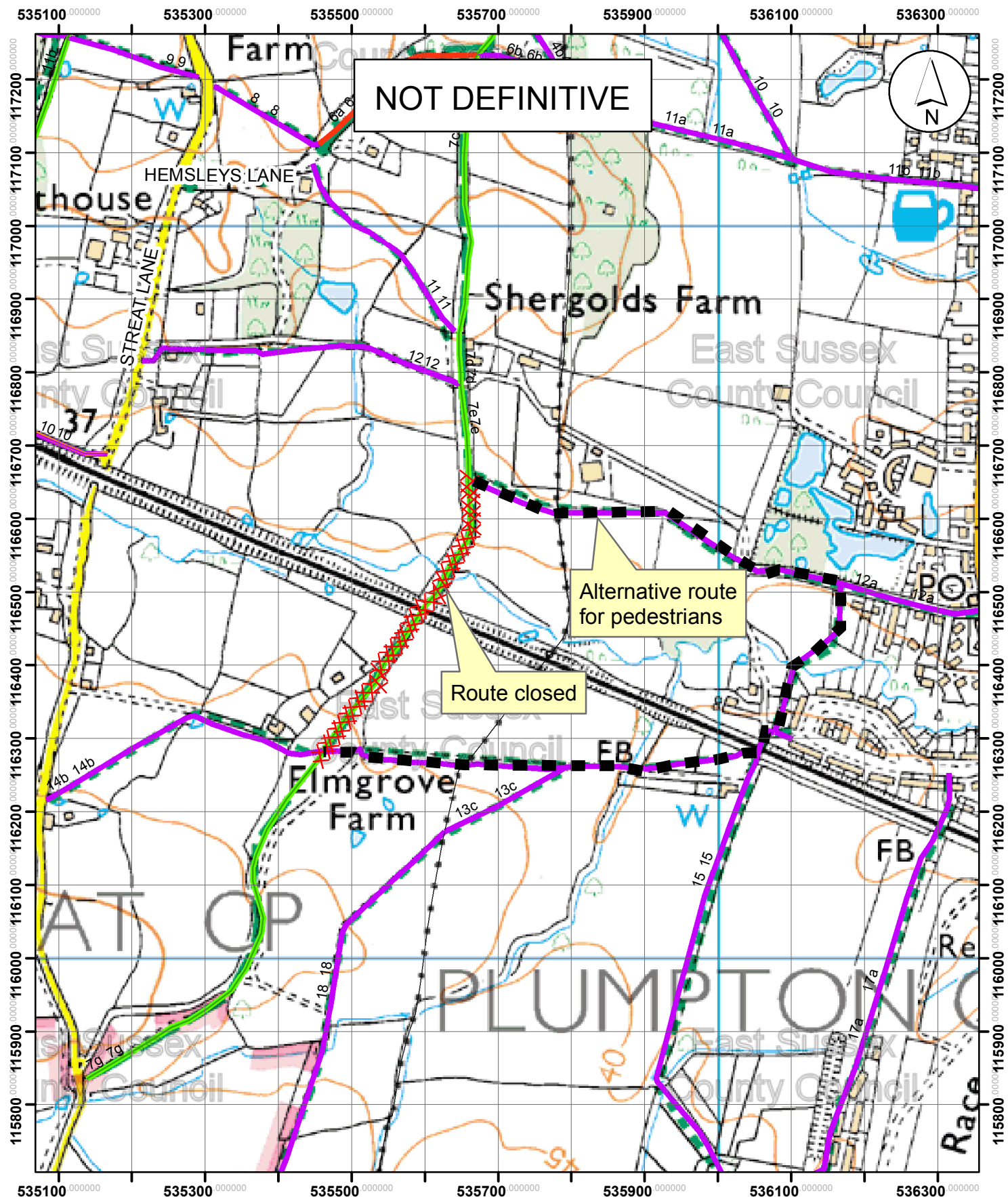
The whole of **Public Bridleway Streat 7f** will be closed to all users between TQ 3546 1628 and TQ 3566 1665. An alternative route will be available for pedestrians only via footpaths Streat 14a, Plumpton 14, 13b, 15, 13a, 12b and Streat 13 and visa versa.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 1 October 2018, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the bridleway still be unfit to use.
