**The East Sussex (Uckfield 34 and Framfield 61b)**

**(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2015**

To protect public safety, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 10 April 2015 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will continue to temporarily close the following footpaths:-

**Temporary Footpath Closure**

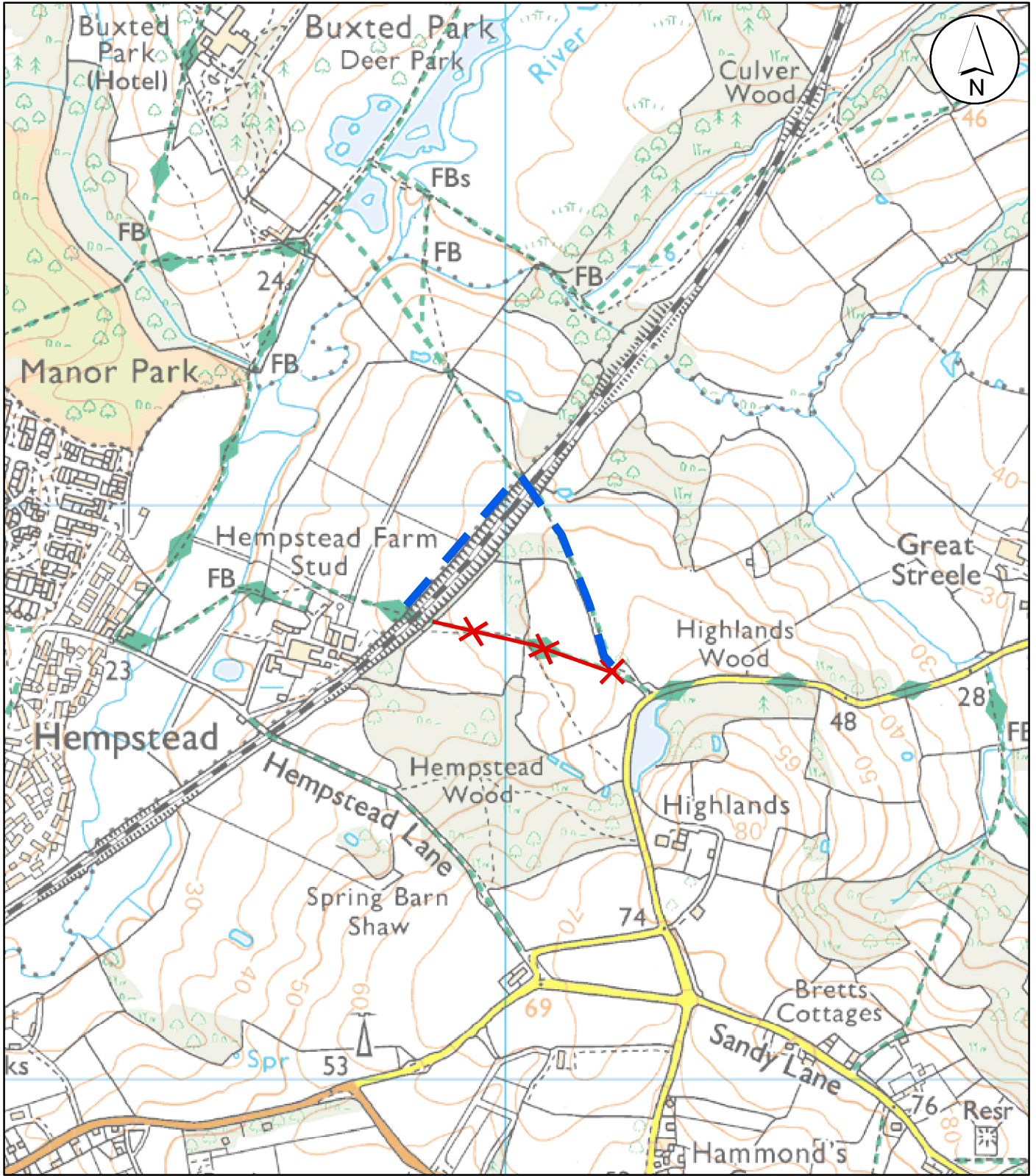
**Public Footpaths Uckfield 34 and Framfield 61b** will be closed to all users at TQ 488 218 (the railway crossing). There are various alternative routes via public footpaths Uckfield 33, Buxted 61d,c and b, 65c, 77, Uckfield 35, 36b, and Framfield 64 to the north or via Hempstead Lane, public footpaths Uckfield 37 and Framfield 62 and roads to the south.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 10 October 2018, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpaths still be unfit to use.
