The East Sussex (Public Footpath Bexhill 88) (Public Footpath Closure) Temporary Notice 2018

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of public footpath Bexhill 88, between TQ 5727 1092 and TQ 5728 1089. The closure is necessary to protect public safety whilst MGJC, Southern Water Partnership replace an existing rising main from Turkey Road to Glenleigh Park Road.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 42 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

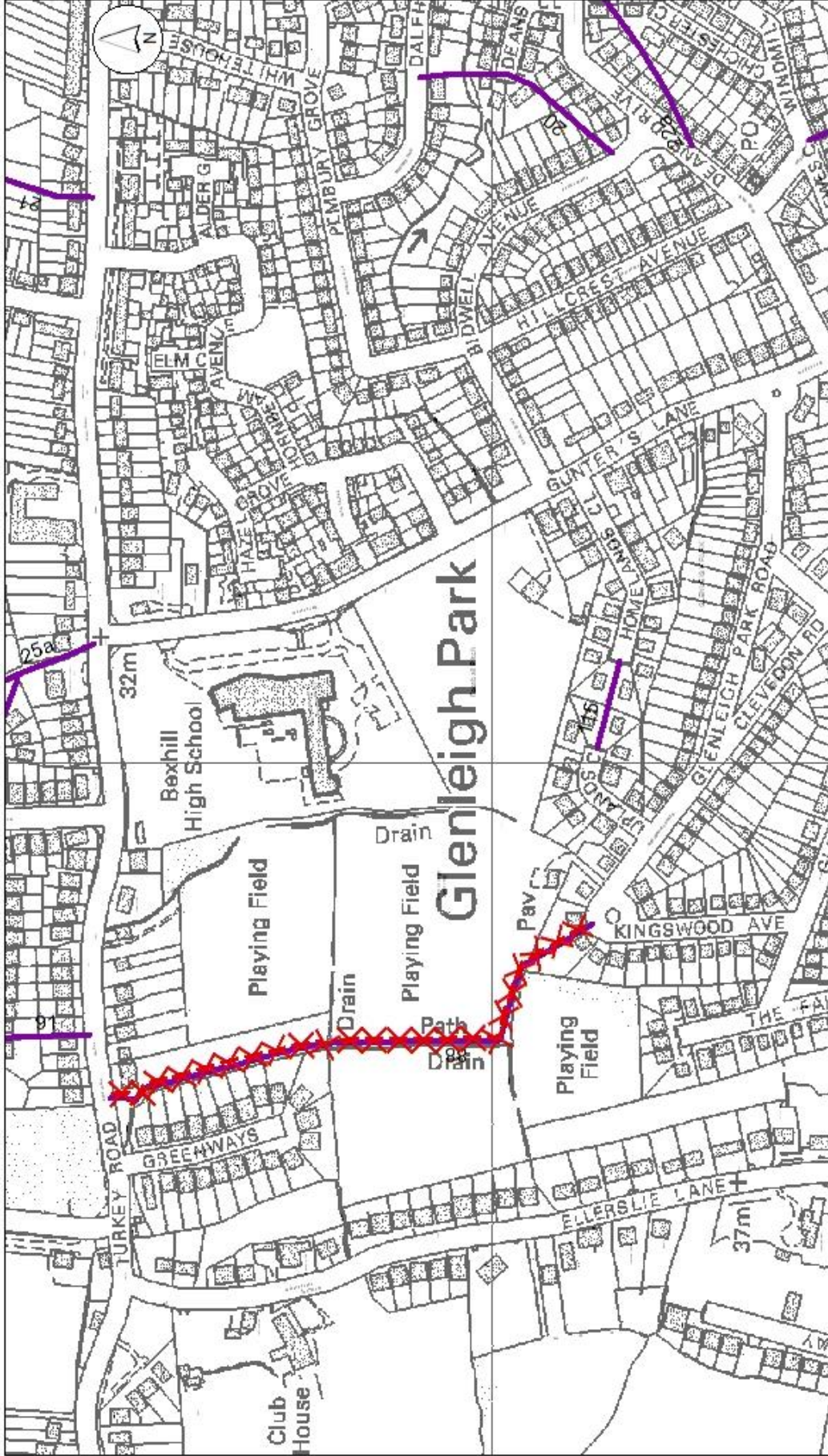
