**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Bexhill 33 (part))
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2018**

To protect public safety during the construction of a new public house/restaurant and Marston's Lodge for Marston's Inn and Taverns, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath

Temporary Footpath Closure

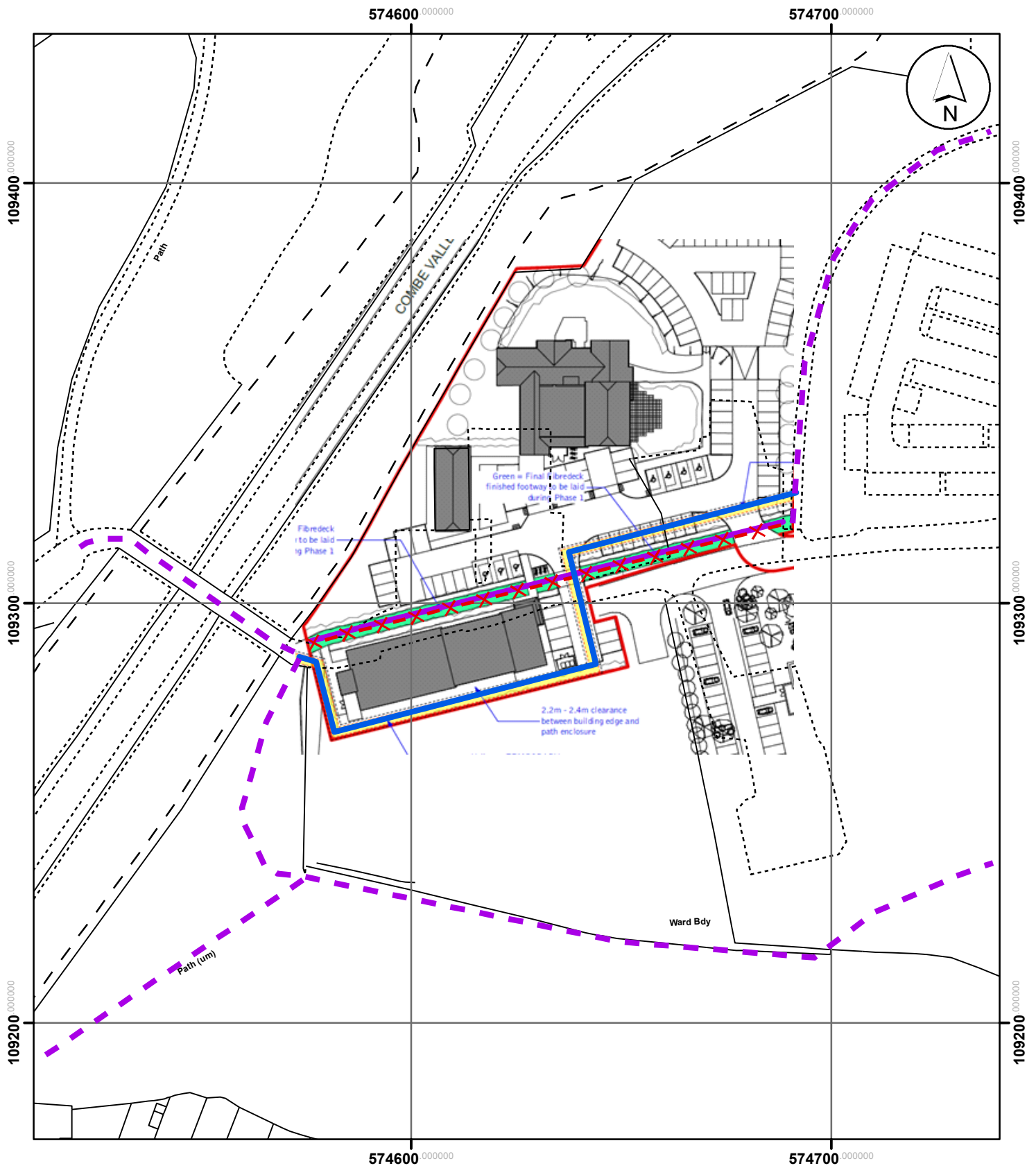
Part of **Public Footpath Bexhill 33** will be closed to all users between TQ 7457 0929 and TQ 7469 0931 for a distance of 120 metres. An alternative route will be available.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 5 November 2018, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
