ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

**The East Sussex (U5122 Southover Road, Lewes)
(Temporary Prohibition of Traffic) Order 2018**

To allow East Sussex Highways to carry out reconstruction works of a retaining wall, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(b) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following length of road;

Temporary Road Closure

U5122 Southover Road - from its junction with U5120 Keere Street to its junction with U5122 Garden Street.

A safe route will be provided for pedestrians and vehicular access for residents and to properties maintained whenever possible with an alternative route for through traffic signed and maintained for the duration of the works via P5849 Station Road – B2193 Priory Street – U5162 Southover High Street and vice versa.

The Order commenced 20 August 2018 and lasts for a period of 18 months, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier. However, it is anticipated the works will now be undertaken between 7 January 2019 and 1 March 2019 depending upon the weather conditions.
