It also replaces a withdrawn 167 journey from Plumpton Half Moon through to Burgess Hill, departing the Half Moon at 07:40. It will not serve Hassocks Station due to problems encountered with parked vehicles (it will continue to stop in Grand Avenue which is about 400 metres away).</p> <p>The 15:50 journey is revised to depart from Burgess Hill Church Road at 16:00, running via Burgess Hill Tesco, Hassocks Stone Pound, Ditchling, Spatham Lane, Westmeston and then as the morning route in reverse to Wivelsfield Green. This journey is timed to depart from Plumpton Station at 16:36, so as to connect with the 16:29 train arrival from Lewes. It replaces the withdrawn route 166 journey which departs from Lewes at 15:55.
