**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Polegate 15 (part))
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2019**

To protect public safety during the construction of a new residential development, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath:

Temporary Footpath Closure

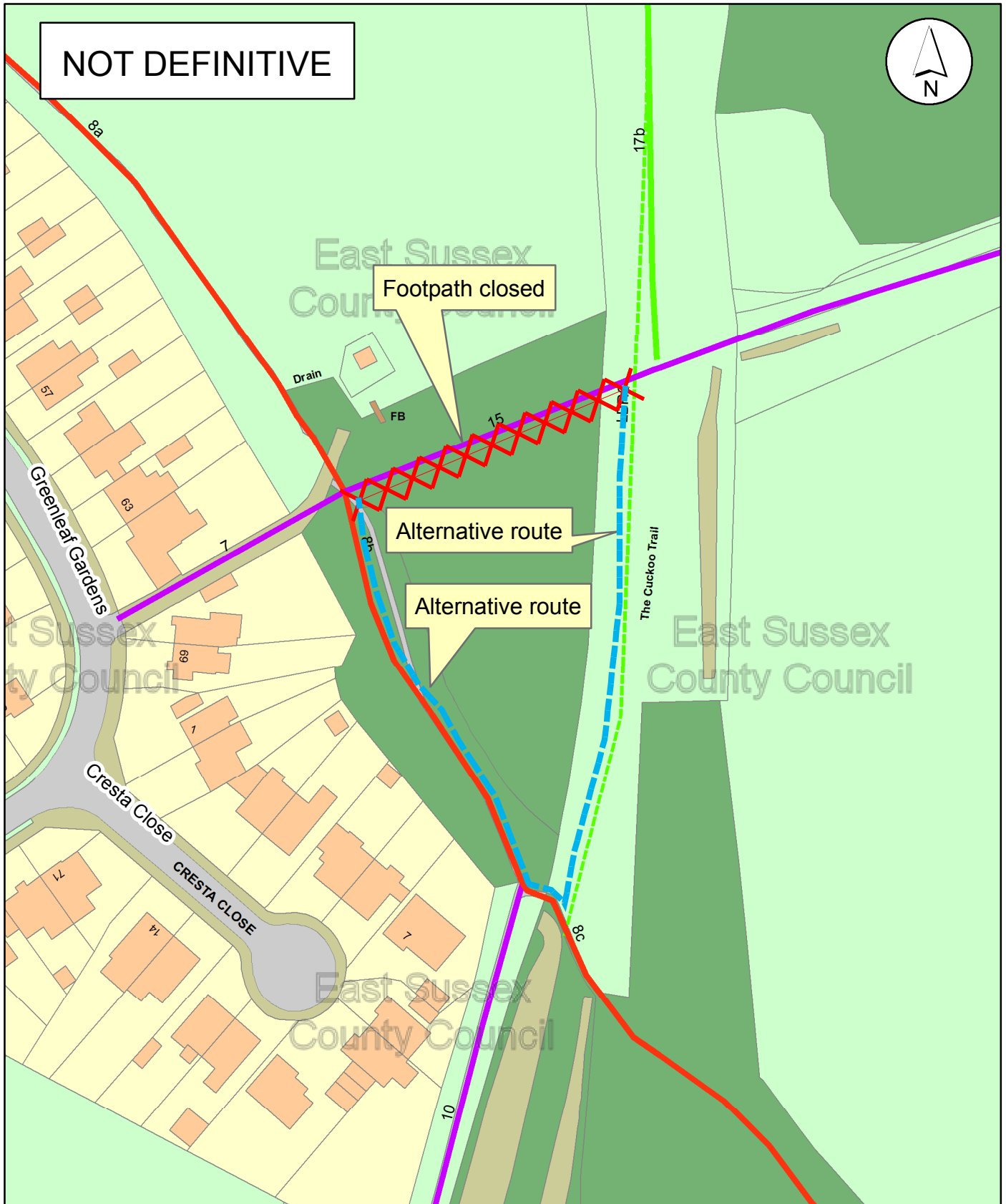
Part of Public Footpath Polegate 15 will be closed to all users between TQ 5844 0549 and TQ 5849 0551 for a distance of 60 metres. An alternative route will be available via Restricted Byways Polegate 8b and Polegate 8c and Licenced Bridleway 6 (Cuckoo Trail) and visa versa.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 1 February 2019, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unavailable to use.
