The East Sussex (Public Footpath Hellingly 55a) (Public Footpath Closure) Temporary Notice 2019

NOTICE is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of public footpath Hellingly 55a, between TQ 55802 11319 and TQ 55749 11378. The closure is needed to protect public safety while a timber footbridge is replaced.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 21 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

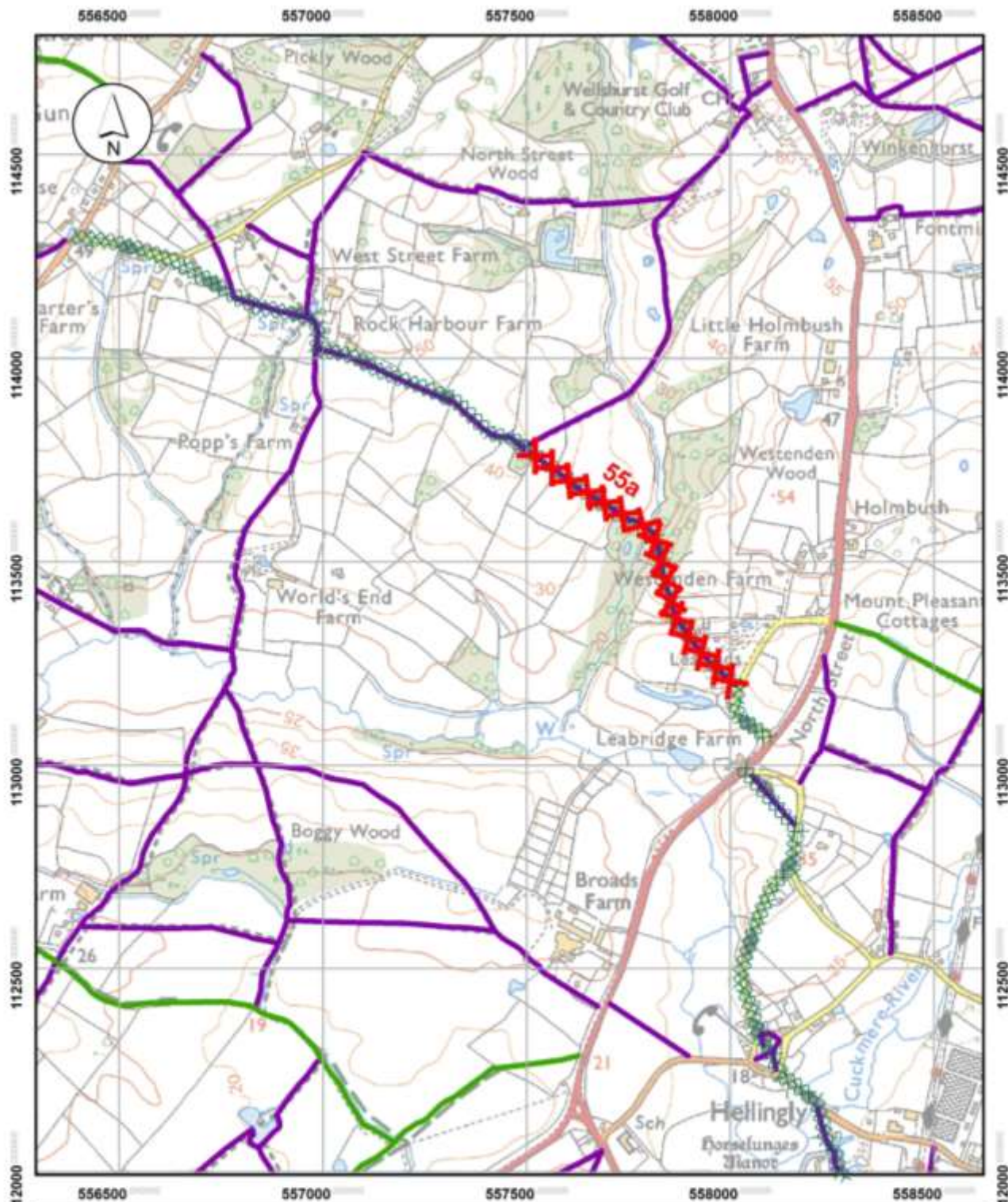
