The East Sussex (Public Footpath Hastings 364a, Hastings 364b and Hastings 417)

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2019

To protect public safety, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 1 November 2019 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpaths:

The following public footpaths lying within the Hastings Country Park at Ecclesbourne Glen will be closed:

The closure will be in force for 18 months from 14 May 2020, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpaths still be unfit to use.
