**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Little Horsted 3)
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2018**

To protect public safety during housing development works, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 20 April 2018 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath:-

Temporary Footpath Closure

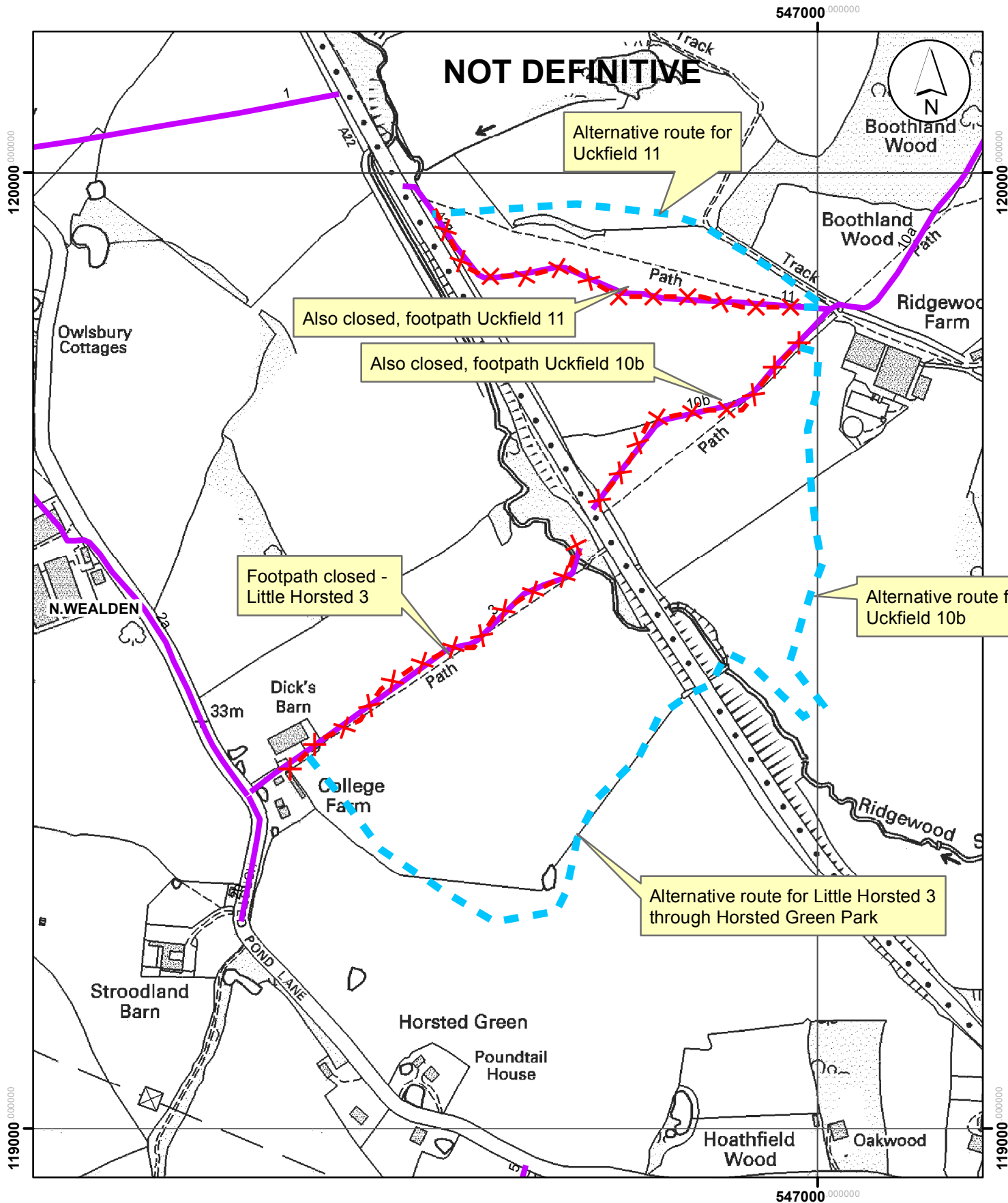
Public Footpath Little Horsted 3 will be closed to all users between TQ 464 194 and TQ 467 195 for 450 metres. An alternative route is available.




The closure will be in force for 12 months from 1 November 2020, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
