**The East Sussex (Chailey 8c, 8d, 8e, 8f, 8g, 8h and part of 8i)**

**(Temporary Byway Closure) Order 2014**

To protect public safety during repairs to a bridge, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 13 June 2014 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following Byways:-

**Temporary Byway Closure**

**Public Byways** Chailey 8c, 8d, 8e, 8f, 8g, 8h and part of 8i, between the junction with Kilnwood Lane for 700 metres to its junction with Setford's Field.

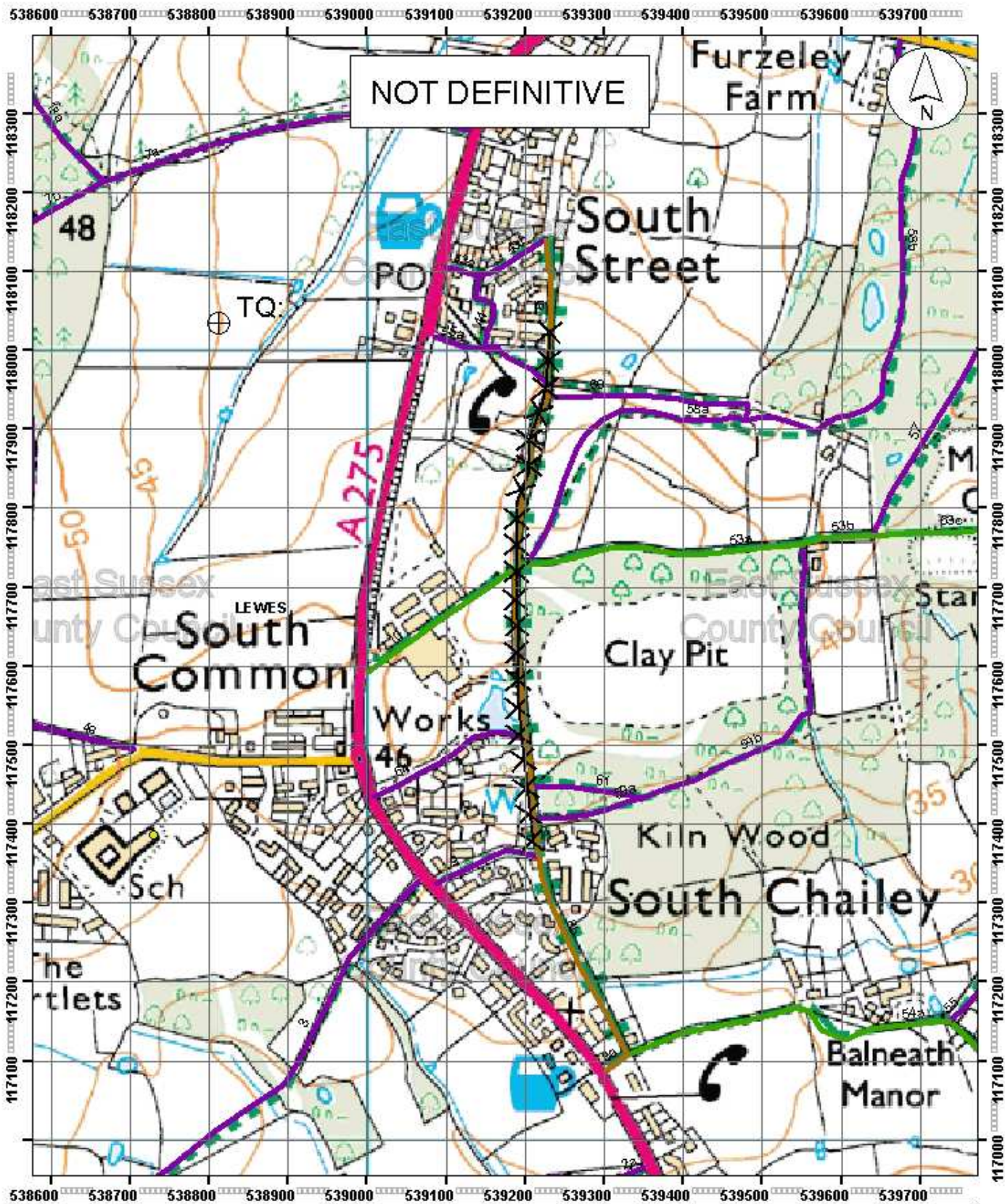
The closure will apply to all users but will remain open to pedestrians, cyclists, horse riders and motorbikes until the repair works begin. This is because the bridge may not currently be safe for vehicles to use.

The closure will be in force for 12 months from 12 December 2020, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the Byway still be unfit to use.
