You will see that the decision was to dismiss the Appeal.

Please note that this decision can only be challenged by an aggrieved person by applying to the Administrative Court for a judicial review for a court order to quash the decision. If quashed, the matter will then go back to the Inspectorate to re-determine.

For applications for judicial review, the Claim form must be filed with the Administrative Court promptly and in any event not later than 3 months after the date of the decision.
