The East Sussex (Footpath Buxted 24, Buxted)

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2012

To protect public safety, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 21 September 2012 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath:-

Temporary Footpath Closure

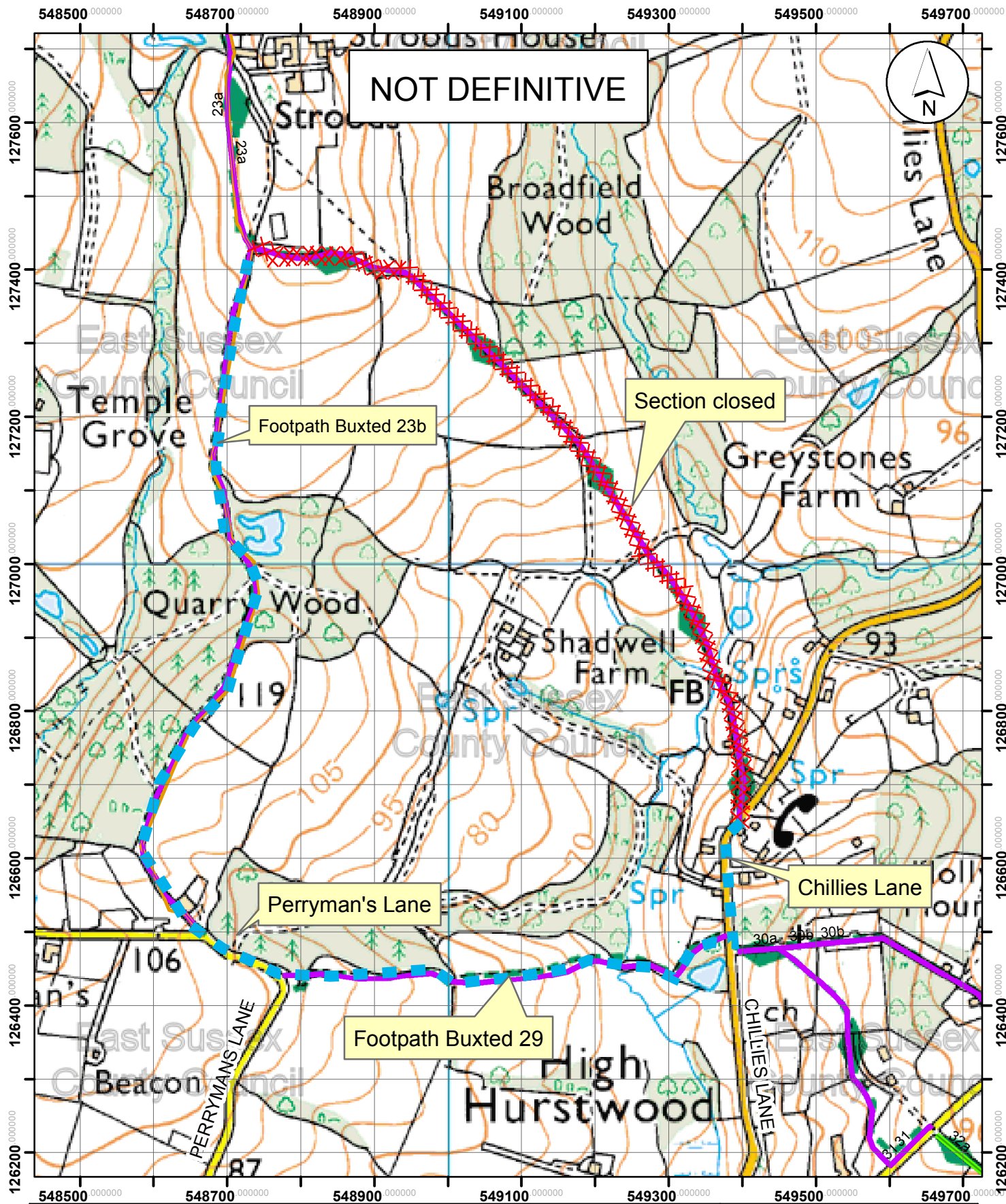
Public Footpath Buxted 24 will be closed between the junction of Buxted Footpath 23 for 1100 metres to its junction with Chillies Lane. The footpath will be closed to all users. An alternative route is available via Chillies Lane, Footpath Buxted 29, Perryman's Lane and Footpath Buxted 23b.

The closure will be in force for 18 months from 30 March 2021, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
