**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Newhaven 7b (part))  
(Public Footpath Closure) Temporary Notice 2021**

**NOTICE** is hereby given that East Sussex County Council in exercise of their powers under Sections 14(2) and 15(8)(b)(ii) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, hereby introduce the following measure with immediate effect:

The temporary closure of part of public footpath Newhaven 7b, between TQ 4527 0067 (Mill Creek Bridge) and TQ 4539 0058 (Tidemills). The closure is needed to protect public safety during surface improvement works. An alternative route is available via the public footpath along the north bank of the Mill Creek.

This Notice shall cease to be in force 5 days from the date of issue, unless it is continued by a successive Temporary Notice issued for a further period of 5 days under Sections 14(2) and 15(8)(b)(ii) or by a Temporary Order made under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended.

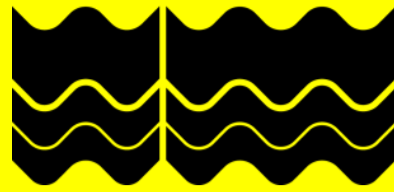
