**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Catsfield 21a (part))
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2016**

To protect public safety during construction works at Ninfield Sub Station, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath

Temporary Footpath Closure

A section of **Public Footpath Catsfield 21a** will be closed between TQ 722 121 and TQ 721 120 for a distance of 130 metres.

An alternative route will be available for the majority of the closure, with the exception of short periods, as signposted on site.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 1 October 2016, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
