**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Hastings 131a)
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2016**

To protect public safety during the construction of the new Queensway Gateway road, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 1 June 2016 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath:

Temporary Footpath Closure

The whole of **Public Footpath Hastings 131a** will be closed between TQ 795 133 and TQ 792 130. An alternative route will be available.

The closure will be in force for 18 months from 1 December 2016, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
