**The East Sussex (Hastings 6, 7 and 8)  
(Temporary Byway Closure) Order 2015**

To protect surface repairs, the Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 27 March 2015 under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following byways:-

**Temporary Byway Closure**

**Byways Hastings 6 and 7** will be closed between the junction with Bexhill Byway 84b and Hastings Footpath 1 at TQ 576488 108163 for 550 metres to the junction with Hastings Footpaths 3 and 4 and Byway 5 at TQ 576921 108469. **Byway Hastings 8** will be closed between its junction with Martyns Way at TQ 576615 108431 for 90 metres to its junction with Byways 6 and 7 at TQ 576705 108414. The path will be **closed to motorised vehicles and motorbikes but open to all other users.**

There are no appropriate alternative routes available. The closure will be in force for 6 months from 27 March 2017, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the byway still be unfit to use.
