**The East Sussex (Public Footpaths Forest Row 34a (part) and 34b  
and Public Bridleways Forest Row 31b (part) and 31c (part))  
(Temporary Footpath and Bridleway Closure) Order 2017**

To protect public safety whilst South East Water lay a new water main, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpaths and bridleways:

**Temporary Footpath and Bridleway Closures**

The whole of **Public Footpath Forest Row 34b** will be closed to all users for **6 months** from TQ 4119 3493 to TQ 4172 3517. There will be no alternative route.

A section of **Public Bridleways Forest Row 31b and 31c** will be closed to all users for **2 weeks** from TQ 4172 3520 to TQ 4172 3514. Timings will be advertised on site. There will be no alternative route.

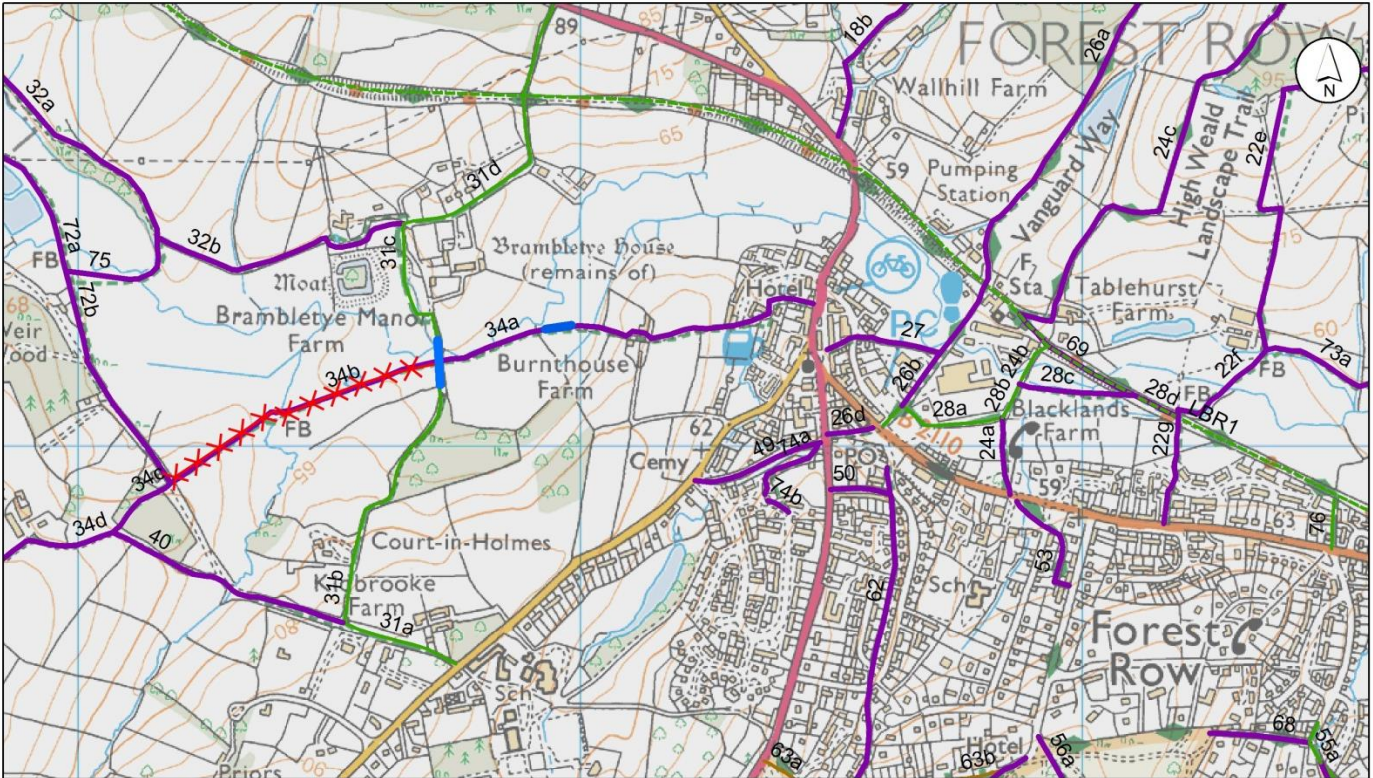
A section of **Public Footpath Forest Row 34a** will be closed to all users for **2 weeks** from TQ 4192 3523 to TQ 4194 3524. Timings will be advertised on site. There will be no alternative route.


The closures will be in force for 6 months from 1 April 2017, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the paths still be unfit to use.
