The East Sussex (Buxted Footpath 24, Buxted)

(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2012

To protect public safety, The Secretary of State has extended the above East Sussex County Council's Order made on 2 October 2012, under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will continue the temporary closure of the following length of Public Footpath:-

Temporary Footpath Closure

Buxted Footpath 24 between the junction of Buxted Footpath 23 for 1100 metres to its junction with Chillies Lane.

The footpath will be closed to all users. An alternative route is available via Chillies Lane, Footpath Buxted 29, Perryman's Lane and Footpath Buxted 23b.

The closure will be in force for 12 months from 2 April 2017, or until the works are completed, whichever is earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
