**The East Sussex (Public Byway Hailsham 36)
(Temporary Byway Closure) Order 2017**

To protect the surface of the byway, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following byway:

Temporary Byway Closure

The whole of **Public byway Hailsham 36**, know as Marshfoot Lane, between TQ 604 096 and TQ 625 097 will be **closed to four wheeled vehicles**. The byway will remain open to walkers, cyclists, horse riders and motorcyclists.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 24 April 2017, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
