**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Ringmer 22)
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2017**

To protect public safety during construction work, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath:

Temporary Footpath Closure

A section of **Public Footpath Ringmer 22** will be closed to all users between TQ 448 128 and TQ 447 130 for a distance of 200 metres. An alternative route will be available through the site.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 3 June 2017, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
