**The East Sussex (Public Footpath Bexhill 16b (part))
(Temporary Footpath Closure) Order 2017**

To protect public safety during construction of the North Bexhill Access Road, East Sussex County Council have made an Order under Sections 14(1) and 15(1)(a) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, which will temporarily close the following footpath:

Temporary Footpath Closure

A section of **Public Footpath Bexhill 16b** will be closed to all users between TQ 7372 1032 and TQ 7374 1027 for a distance of 55 metres. An alternative route will be available.

The closure will be in force for 6 months from 7 August 2017, or until the works are completed, whichever is the earlier, which after this period will require an extension from the Secretary of State, should the footpath still be unfit to use.
